## Goal of the workshop



- Understand how students complete a collaborative mural and what their teacher should prepare and support

## Style of murals

- Q1: What is a theme of your mural?
  - culture / nature / daily life / legends/ environment /
- Q2: Are students going to draw about **their own culture** or a culture of **their partner's country**?
- Q3: Is the style of a mural **puzzled** or **halved**?
  - Puzzled: draw individually and joint each work
  - Halved: draw a half image of the mural each other and joint it

## Learning activity cards are...

### Drawing

- Draw a rough sketch
- Color
- Appreciate the work

### Activities

- Research our own and the other culture
- Make a paper or a video message
- Reflect on their activities

### Communication

- Introduce oneself and one's school
- Show and tell one's life
- Discuss a theme, schedule and cooperation

## Drawing



- The flow of drawing is mostly static.
  - Make a plan → Draw a rough sketch → Color the sketch → Send and Receive the work → Appreciate the work
- What you should consider is...
  - When are each activity suitable?
  - Which is the school drawing first?
  - It depends on holidays in each school and the style of mural.

## Activity



- What **activities** are needed to draw a mural?
  - Introduce oneself and your school and your country
  - Research your country or the partner's country
  - Exchange daily life

## Communication



- What **communication tools** are effective and feasible?
  - Video conference
  - Video message
  - BBS(Bulletin board system)
  - Exchange teddy bears
  - Blog / Web / Chatting

## 5 Steps for completing your project

1. Confirm **holidays** in each other's school year
2. Decide **style** of your mural
  - Theme
  - Draw about your own country or your partner's country
  - Puzzled or halved
3. Put **drawing cards** on suitable term
4. What **activities** are needed to draw a mural?
